### GENOCIDE RESEARCH & POSTER ASSIGNMENT

You have been assigned to study the genocide in \_\_\_\_\_. Over the next three days, your task is to answer the following questions and colorfully display the answers on a poster board. Use websites, encyclopedias, genocide books, films, etc. to research the questions. Be prepared to present your findings to the class next week.

1. **Quadrant One, Upper Left Corner—Where:** Where did this genocide take place? Describe the location, its population at the time, the climate.
2. **Quadrant Two, Upper Right Corner—What:** Summarize the genocide by presenting basic facts of what happened, when etc.
3. **Quadrant Three, Lower Left Corner—Who:** Which groups were chosen for extermination? What was the ultimate death toll? Which groups were responsible for the mass killings? What were their motives?
4. **Quadrant Four, Lower Right Corner—World Response:** Did the rest of the world, especially the United States, know about this genocide? What was the response of the rest of the world to this genocide?
5. **At The Bottom of The Poster—**In several sentences provide personal reflection about the genocide you researched.
