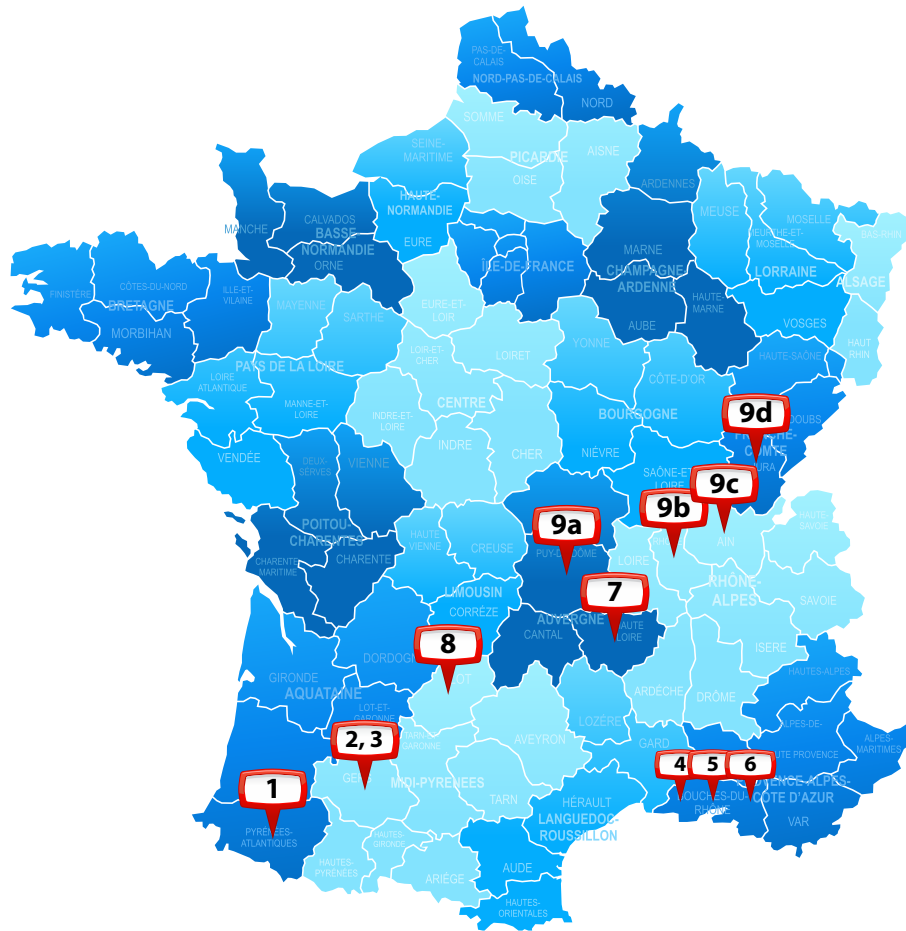


A Timeline of Peter Feigl's Journey, 1940—1944, Using a Department Map of France



1	May 1940–July 1940	Gurs Camp in Pyrénées-Atlantiques department
2	July 1940–July 1942	Auch in Gers department
3	July 1942–November 4, 1942	Summer Camp/Children's Home at the Château de Montéléone in Gers department
4	November 4, 1942–December 26, 1942	Children's Colony at Les Caillols in Bouches-du-Rhône department
5	December 27, 1942–January 4, 1943	Children's Colony at La Rouvière in Bouches-du-Rhône department
6	January 5, 1943–January 15, 1943	Children's Colony at Les Caillols in Bouches-du-Rhône department
7	January 16, 1943–September 1943	Children's Home at Les Grillons, Le Chambon-sur-Lignon, in the Haute-Loire department
8	September 1943*–May 18, 1944	Boarding School at Collège Champollion, Figeac, in Lot Department
9	May 19, 1944–May 22, 1944	Escape to Switzerland via a) Clermont-Ferrand in the Puy-de-Dôme department, b) Lyons in the Rhône department, c) Culoz in the Ain department, and d) Viry in the Jura department
